Commissioner Livasy and Manager Gillis are available to answer questions and provide current information on the following items:

- 1. Signalization of the Silver Lake/Franke Road Intersection** – The signal work is proceeding and should be complete in the next three weeks.
- 2. Sale of MTF Bonds** –The bond sale is scheduled for Tuesday, September 2, 2008 at 11:00 A.M. with a conference call with the Road Commission to accept any hand-delivered, local bids.
- 3. Road Improvement Partnerships**
 - a. Current Projects with the County** – Projects completed thus far include Cass Road, Barlow Street, West Silver Lake Road, Silver Lake Road and Peninsula Drive with North Long Lake Road scheduled next.
 - b. New Projects with the County** - Bids received on August 4, 2008 to expend the balance of the \$4 million. Elmer's Crane & Dozer, the low bidder, was awarded the projects for \$963,316.00. Subject to available funding, these are the proposed road projects: U.) Hammond Road, 3 Mile Road to 4 Mile Road, V.) Three Mile Road, Hammond Road to Cherry Ridge Way, W.) Three Mile Road, Cherry Ridge Way to Potter Road, X.) Elk Lake Road, Park Road to Angell Road, Y.) Hobbs Highway, North Spider Lake Road to Supply Road, Z.) Hobbs Highway, East Arbutus Lake Road to Harold's Road and AA.) Hobbs Highway, Harold's Road to Scout Camp Road.
 - c. Bureau of Indian Affairs/Grand Traverse Band** – Bids to improve Lautner Road were also received on August 4, 2008 with Elmer's Crane & Dozer being awarded the project for \$359,962.40. Bates Road is anticipated to be constructed in 2009.
