Traverse City. **All work is weather permitting.** This is the road work schedule for the week starting Monday, April 20, 2020.

ROAD CLOSURES

Garfield Road, Village of Kingsley north to the Railroad Tracks – Paradise Township

- *This section of road will be closed for a culvert replacement. Detour of M-113 to Clark to Voice.
- *We anticipate the work to start and be completed on Monday, April 20, 2020.
- *This section of road will be closed to thru traffic.
- *Motorists are advised to follow posted detour signs.

LANE CLOSURES

High Lake Road, Supply to Hammond – East Bay Township

- *Lane Closures for repaving.
- *This will be directed by flag control. Please obey flaggers.
- *This is expected to start on Monday, April 20, 2020 and last two days.

Hammond Road, Four Mile to High Lake Road – East Bay Township

- *The East bound lane will be closed for shoulder work.
- *This is expected for Monday, April 20, 2020 and Tuesday, April 21, 2020.
- *This will be directed by flag control. Please obey flaggers.
