Traverse City. All work is weather permitting. This is the road work schedule for the week of October 26, 2020.

#### **ROAD CLOSURE**

##### **Peninsula Drive – Gray Road to Island View Road, Peninsula Township**

\*Due to a washout, this section of road is CLOSED. Access will be available to residents.

\*South of address 10460 Peninsula Drive will need to use Gray Road; North of this address will need to use Island View Road.

\*Motorists are expected to follow posted detour signs.

##### **Peninsula Drive – North of Island View Road, Peninsula Township**

\*Following repairs near 10460 Peninsula Drive. Contractors will begin repairs on a washout near 12012 Peninsula Drive.

\*Due to a washout, this section of road will be CLOSED during repairs access north of 12012 will need to use Bowers Harbor Rd. Access will be available to residents.

\*Motorists are expected to follow posted detour signs.

##### **M-72 – E Angus Rd to E Angus Rd, Garfield Township/Elmwood Township**

\*Lane Closure due to a washout. West bound right lane will be closed for slope repairs.

\*Work is expected to start Monday November 26, 2020

\*Please use caution where workers are present.

##### **Hammond Road – Garfield Road to Townline Road, Garfield Township**

\*This is a crush and shape project.

\*Work at Townline intersection has begun. Access to Townline, South of Hammond, will be maintained.

\*No thru traffic is allowed between **Garfield Road and Three Mile Road**, access will be made available to residents and businesses.

Access for residents and businesses will need to access from Garfield Road.

\*Motorists are advised to use South Airport and are expected to follow posted detour signs.

\*This project is expected to be completed by November 7, 2020.

#### **TRAFFIC SIGNALS**

##### **Birmley and Keystone**

\*The Signal at Birmely and Keystone will cycle regularly between 6:00AM and 10:00PM. It will no longer be in flash mode between these hours but will still be in flash mode throughout the night.

\*This will remain until the Hammond Road Project is completed.

\*Please use caution when approaching this intersection.

#### **CRACK FILL – MOVING OPERATION**


