#### **FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE**

Traverse City. All work is weather permitting. This is the road work schedule for the week starting Tuesday, June 1, 2021.

#### **ROAD CLOSURES**

##### **River Road, Keystone to Garfield (Blair and East Bay Townships)**

\*River Road West Bridge demolition/construction continues. This project is expected to be completed in September.

\*No thru traffic is allowed, access will be made available to residents and businesses. Address 1447 River Road and up will need to use Garfield and address 1387 River Road and down will need to use Keystone.

\*Motorists are advised to follow posted detour signs.

##### **Walton Road, Blackman Road to 100' West of the Railroad Tracks (Paradise Township)**

\*This project continues and is expected to last until Thursday, August 26<sup>th</sup>.

\*This is a crush and shape project.

\*No thru traffic is allowed, access will be made available to residents and businesses.

\*Motorists are advised to follow posted detour signs.

##### **Cass Road, near Miller Creek Road (Garfield Township)**

\*Crews for the Grand Traverse County Drain Commission will be working on a Culvert Replacement starting Thursday, June 3, 2021 at 8:00 AM and is expected to last through July 20, 2021. This is part of the Cass Road Stormwater Improvement Project to improve the management of stormwater for the area.

\*This portion of road will be closed. Detour signs will be posted.

\*Please expect delays and follow posted detours.

#### **LANE CLOSURES**

##### **Garfield Road, South of River Road – Boardman River Crossing (Paradise Township)**

\*Garfield Road demolition/construction of the Bridge continues. This project is expected to last until the end of July.

\*Traffic will be reduced to one lane, controlled by a temporary traffic signal.

**\*Reduced lane width to 9 feet. No over width loads.**

\*Please use caution in this area. Obey traffic cones and signs. Expect delays or seek an alternate route.

##### **ADVANCED NOTICE - US-31, Acme Culvert Replacement – North of Grand Traverse Report and South of Brackett Road, Acme Township**

\*Crews will begin work the week of June 7<sup>th</sup>. This project is expected to last three days.

\*Traffic will be reduced to one lane, controlled by flaggers.

\*Please use caution in this area. Obey traffic cones and signs. Expect delays or seek an alternate route.
