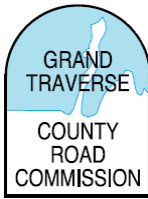

The Grand Traverse County Road Commission will be hosting the first public meeting for the Boardman River Crossing Focused PEL Study on Wednesday, July 14<sup>th</sup> from 2:00 PM to 4:30 PM. The meeting will be held at the Networks Northwest Conference Center at 1209 S. Garfield Avenue, Traverse City.

The meeting will begin with a presentation summarizing the work completed to date, followed by an open house where community members can view project boards and talk to project team members to learn more about options being considered for a potential crossing of the Boardman River. Participants will also be able to submit feedback and input on the project through paper and digital comment cards. The presentation will be recorded and posted to the project website for viewing by those who are unable to attend the meeting. Residents will be able to leave feedback on the project website by using the online public input survey. The project website is located here:
