Traverse City. **All work is weather permitting.** This is the road work schedule for the week of August 9, 2021.

ROAD CLOSURES

Hammond Road and Four Mile, Intersection - Stage 2A (East Bay Township)

- *Roundabout work continues. Stage 2A is expected to be completed by September 8th. The entire project is expected to be completed September 30th.
- *Access is available for Westbound traffic ONLY on Hammond Road.
- *Four Mile Road, North of Hammond, can access Westbound Hammond ONLY.
- *Four Mile Road, South of Hammond, is closed at the intersection.
- *All other traffic will need to follow posted detour signs.
- *Do not cut through the private condominiums.
- *Expect delays. Obey traffic cones, signs, and barricades.

River Road, Keystone to Garfield (Blair and East Bay Townships)

- *River Road EAST Bridge construction continues. This project is expected to be completed in September.
- *No thru traffic is allowed, access will be made available to residents and businesses. Address 2021 River Road and up will need to use Garfield and address 2011 River Road and down will need to use Keystone.
- *Motorists are advised to follow posted detour signs.

LANE CLOSURES

M-72/East Traverse Highway – E. Angus Road to Tom's West Bay (Garfield Township)

- *Crews continue to work on the curb and spillway.
- *The Northernmost lane will be closed.
- *Please use caution in this area. Obey traffic cones and signs. Expect delays or seek an alternate route.

ROAD COMMISSION CREW ACTIVITIES

- *Pothole Patching - Various Locations.
- *Shoulder Work – Various Locations.
- *Ditching – Various Locations.
- *Mowing – Various Locations.
- *Catch Basin Cleaning – Various Locations.
