ROAD CLOSURES

Meadow Lane (Garfield Township)

*Crews are finishing up this project. This is funded by the Grand Traverse Band of Ottawa and Chippewa Indians.

*No thru traffic is allowed, access will be made available to residents and businesses.

Springbrook SAD, Circle View and Westridge Drive (Acme Township)

*Crews will be working on a crush and shape.

*This project is expected to be completed by the end of day, Friday, October 15th.

*No thru traffic is allowed, access will be available to residents.

LANE CLOSURES

State Highways – Various Locations, Grand Traverse County

*Crews will be working on the shoulders of the State Highways in the County.

*This project is expected to last a couple of weeks.

*This is a moving operation and traffic will be directed by flaggers.

*Please obey traffic flaggers and signs. Use caution when going through this area.

Overlay Projects

Davis Road – Grant Township

*Crews will be working Monday, October 6th starting at 7:30AM.

*Roadways will be reduced to one lane, directed by flag control.

*Expect delays or seek an alternate route.

Miller Road – Mayfield Township

*Crews will be starting Tuesday, October 7th starting at 7:30AM and should be completed by end of day, Wednesday, October 8th.

*Roadways will be reduced to one lane, directed by flag control.
