Traverse City. All work is weather permitting. This is the road work schedule for the week starting Monday, May 2nd, 2022.

ROAD CLOSURE

Cedar Run Road, Anna Drive to Gray Hawk Garfield Township)

*Crews will continue working on Water Mains. This section of road will be closed to ALL traffic.
*This project is expected to last 2-3 weeks.
*Please seek an alternate route. Obey signs and traffic cones.

LANE CLOSURE

Four Mile Road at US31 (East Bay)

*CC Power crews will be working on power lines.
*The right-turn only lane will be closed for the duration of the day.
*Work will take place Tuesday, May 3rd at 9:00AM until complete.
*Please use caution in this area. Obey traffic cones and signs. Expect delays or seek an alternate route.

M-37, M-113 to Countyline (Mayfield Township)

*Crews will be working on shoulders. Work is expected to last throughout the week.
*This is a moving operation. Where workers are present, there will be lane closures. Traffic will be controlled by flaggers.
*Please use caution in this area. Obey traffic cones and signs. Expect delays or seek an alternate route.

TRAFFIC SIGNALS

South Airport Road and Barlow Road/LaFranier Road (Garfield)

*Crews will continue working on finalizing the traffic signal and will be in the Right of Way. Signs will be posted in the work area. There will be intermittent traffic stops/holds throughout the day. This will be controlled by flaggers.
*Work will continue Monday, May 2nd, at 8:00AM.
*Please use caution in this area. Obey signs and traffic cones.

ROAD COMMISSION CREW ACTIVITIES

*Crews will continue working on ditching throughout Union Township. Work is expected to last a couple of months.
