Traverse City. **All work is weather permitting.** This is the road work schedule for the week starting Monday, June 20th, 2022.

ROAD CLOSURE

Townline Road, E. Sparling Road and Walton Road (Fife Lake/Paradise Township)

- *Crews will continue working on a crush and shape project.
- *The road is closed to thru traffic.
- *Work will continue.
- *Please seek an alternate route. Slow down, obey traffic signs and cones.

Vanderlip Road, Just East of Three Mile, (East Bay Township)

- *Crews will be working on installing a new sewer main.
- *Work will begin Monday, June 20th at 7:00AM.
- *The road is closed to traffic in this construction area.
- *Work is expected to be completed in two (2) weeks.
- *Please seek an alternate route.

LANE CLOSURE

ROUNDAABOUT - Keystone Road Detour (River Road and Cass Road Roundabouts)

- *Cass Road will be closed at the Keystone Road Intersection.
- *Cass Road traffic will not be able to access Keystone Road.
- *Keystone Road will be one-way. Northbound ONLY from River Road. River Road will ONLY be able to go Northbound on Keystone.
- *Southbound Keystone traffic will need to use South Airport and US31/M37.
- *Soccer traffic will be able to enter the Soccer Complex from the South and the North. When exiting, traffic will go Northbound ONLY.
- *Please expect delays or seek an alternate route.

SHOULDER CLOSURE

Hammond Road, between High Lake Road and Four Mile (East Bay Township)

- *DTE crews will be working on a gas line.
- *Work will begin Monday, June 20th at 7:30AM and is expected to be completed by end of day.
- *Please slow down and use caution in this area.
