Traverse City. **All work is weather permitting.** This is the road work schedule for the week starting Monday, July 18th, 2022.

LANE CLOSURE

ROUNDBOUT - Keystone Road Detour (River Road and Cass Road Roundabouts)

- *Cass Road will be closed at the Keystone Road Intersection.
- *Cass Road traffic will not be able to access Keystone Road.
- *Keystone Road will be one-way. Northbound ONLY from River Road. River Road will ONLY be able to go Northbound on Keystone.
- *Southbound Keystone traffic will need to use South Airport and US31/M37.
- *Soccer traffic will be able to enter the Soccer Complex from the South and the North. When exiting, traffic will go Northbound ONLY.
- *Please expect delays or seek an alternate route.

Vanderlip Road, Just East of Three Mile, (East Bay Township)

- *Crews will continue working on the water main.
- *The Eastbound Lane will be closed in this area.
- *Traffic will be directed by flaggers.
- *Please slow down and use caution in this area.

Three Mile Road, Vanderlip Road to South Airport (East Bay Township)

- *Crews will be working on upgrading the shoulders and paving an entrance just North of Vanderlip Road.
- *Work will begin, Monday July 18th, 2022, at 7:00 AM.
- *Work is expected to be completed by end of day, Thursday, July 21st.
- *Please use caution and expect delays.

LANE SHIFT

Barlow Road, South Airport to the City Limits (Garfield Township)

- *Crews will continue working on the gas main project.
- *There will be intermittent lane shifts throughout the week.
- *Work will begin Monday, July 11th at 7:00AM and is expected to continue throughout the week.
- *Please use caution in this area.

ROAD COMMISSION CREW ACTIVITIES

- *Crews will continue working on ditching throughout Fife Lake Township. Anyone nearby interested in fill dirt, please call our office at 231-922-4848. Please slow down and use caution in this area.
- *Pothole Patching – Various Locations.
- *Shoulder Maintenance – Various Locations.
- *Mowing – Various Main Highways and Local Roads.
