Traverse City. **All work is weather permitting.** This is the road work schedule for the week starting Monday, August 1st, 2022.

ROAD CLOSURE

Hoch Road at Keystone Intersection (Blair/Garfield Townships)

- *Crews will be replacing the railroad tracks at this location and creating a designated right and left turn lane.
- *Work will begin on Monday, August 1st at 6:00AM. Work is expected to last for three weeks.
- *This section of Hoch Road will be closed to ALL traffic. All traffic will need to access from the East.
- *Please allow extra time for your commute.

LANE CLOSURE

Three Mile Road, Vanderlip Road to South Airport (East Bay Township)

- *Crews will continue working on upgrading the shoulders and paving an entrance just North of Vanderlip Road.
- *Please use caution and expect delays.

SHOULDER CLOSURE

Vanderlip Road, Just East of Three Mile, (East Bay Township)

- *Crews will continue working on the water main.
- *Please slow down and use caution in this area.

LANE SHIFT

Barlow Road, South Airport to the City Limits (Garfield Township)

- *Crews will continue working on the gas main project.
- *There will be intermittent lane shifts throughout the week.
- *Work will continue.
- *Please use caution in this area.

ROAD COMMISSION CREW ACTIVITIES

- *Crews will continue working on ditching throughout Fife Lake Township and will start in Acme Township. Please slow down and use caution in these areas.
- *Pothole Patching – Various Locations.
- *Shoulder Maintenance – Various Locations.
- *Mowing – Various Main Highways, Primary and Local Roads.
