All work is weather permitting. This is the road work schedule for the week of May 12th, 2024.

ROAD CLOSURE

Garfield Rd/Potter Rd Roundabout (Garfield Township)

*Work is expected to take place between April 22nd and June 25th, 2024.

*The intersection will be CLOSED during construction. The posted detour will use Three Mile and Hammond Roads.

* If you are able, seek an alternate route.

*Please plan ahead, be patient and expect delays.

*Slow down where workers are present.

S. Rahe Road, between M-113 and Center Road - (Mayfield Township)

*Crews will be working on replacing a culvert, as part of a gravel road improvement project.

*Work continues between 7:00AM and 4:00PM. This project is expected to last up to a month.

*The culvert replacement is near M-113, so most of the traffic will need to access from Center Road.

* If you are able, seek an alternate route.

*Please plan ahead, be patient and expect delays.

*Slow down where workers are present.

LANE CLOSURES

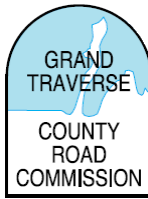
Forest Lodge Road (Long Lake Township)

*Work continues. Work is expected to last a couple of weeks.

*This is a crush and shape project.

*Traffic will be maintained by flaggers.

West Silver Lake Road near Green Meadow Drive to just North of East Silver Lake Road (Long Lake Township)

- *Work will continue. This project is expected to be completed by the end of May.
- *Crews will be installing a water main.
- *Traffic will be maintained by flaggers.
- *Please expect delays.

Chip Seal Projects – Various Locations

- *Chip Seal will continue. Work will take place between 7:00AM and 7:00PM.
- *Roadways will be reduced to one lane, directed by flag control.
- *Expect delays.

PAVEMENT MARKINGS (Countywide)

- *The Contractor will continue applying wet paint on various roads between 7:00AM and 7:00PM.
- *These are "moving operations" meaning operations are short-lived in any one location.
- *Motorists should reduce speed and obey traffic control devices.

ROAD COMMISSION CREW ACTIVITIES

- *Pothole Patching – Various Locations.
- *Tree Trimming – Various Locations.
- *Sign Repair - Various Locations.
- *Ditching – Various Locations.
