All work is weather permitting. This is the road work schedule for the week of July 15th, 2024.

ROAD CLOSURE

Diamond Park Road at the Bridge, between 10185 and 10250 Diamond Park Road (Green Lake Township)

*Crews will continue working on the bridge. This project is expected to last until September 2nd.

*Traffic will not be able to get through and will need to utilize Karlin Road and Betsie River Road.

*Please plan accordingly and expect a longer commute.

UPCOMING PROJECTS

*S. Long Lake Road/W. Long Lake Road Intersection reconstruction starts Monday, July 22nd.

This project will include modifying the vertical curve at the S. Long Lake Rd/ W. Long Lake Rd intersection, crushing and shaping W. Long Lake Rd from S. Long Lake Rd to north of Lakewood Dr, culvert replacements, guardrail upgrades and pavement markings.

The first portion of the project will begin on 7/22/2024 and will include replacing culverts on W. Long Lake Rd. During this time W. Long Lake Rd will be closed to thru traffic. The detour for this work will utilize Secor Rd, E Long Lake Rd and N. Long Lake Rd.

On 7/29/24 the next stage of the project will begin. This portion of the project will include the hill cut at the S. Long Lake Rd/W. Long Lake Rd intersection. To maintain traffic during this stage the contractor will close S. Long Lake Rd from the intersection at W. Long Lake Rd to the east. The detour will utilize W. Long Lake Rd, N. Long Lake Rd, East Long Lake Rd and Secor Rd. There will be times when traffic will be maintained on a gravel surface.

Once the hill cut has been completed W. Long Lake Rd will be closed to allow the crushing and shaping of the existing paved surface and placement of the new asphalt surface the detour will utilize N. Long Lake Rd, E. Long Lake Rd, and Secor Rd.

All work is expected to be completed by 8/30/2024.
