All work is weather permitting. This is the road work schedule for the week of September 3rd, 2024.

ROAD CLOSURE

S. Long Lake Road/W. Long Lake Road Intersection - (Long Lake Township)

- *Crews will be working on reconstructing this intersection.
- *Work should take place between 7:00AM and 7:00PM. The entire project is expected to last until the middle of September.
- *S. Long Lake Road will be closed at the intersection with W. Long Lake Road and extend approximately 1,000 feet east of this intersection.
- *Traffic will need to utilize W. Long Lake Rd, N. Long Lake Rd, E. Long Lake Rd and Secor Rd.
- *Please plan ahead, be patient and expect delays.
- *Slow down where workers are present.

Zue Road, Pavlis Road to County Road 633 - (Grant Township)

- *Crews will continue working on a crush and shape project. Work is expected to take place between 7:00AM and 7:00PM.
- *Zue Road will be closed to thru traffic. Please utilize County Road 633, W. County Line Road and Pavlis Road. Local traffic will be directed by flaggers.
- *Work is expected to be completed by the end of the week of September 2nd.
- *Please expect delays.

Diamond Park Road at the Bridge (Green Lake Township)

- *Crews will sealing the bridge on Wednesday, September 4th and is expected to be completed by the end of day.
- *Traffic will not be able to get through and will need to utilize Karlin Road and Betsie River Road.
- *Please plan accordingly and expect a longer commute.
