SAFETY VIDEO & VESTS

Just a reminder, all participants must review the **safety video each year prior to executing the first pick-up**. It is important that each person wear a vest while moving along the roadways; however, if you have a large group and not enough vests, the person closest to the road should wear a vest.

BAGS/VESTS

If you need trash bags or vests for your pickups, please feel free to stop in at any time during business hours to pick them up!

SIGNS

Please help our sign crew by checking your sign during your first pick up and let us know if it is missing or the post is down.

REPORTING YOUR PICK-UP

Please email or call when each collection has been completed to ensure routes are being maintained. Please place the bags as close together as possible and near a landmark so our crews can easily spot them. Pick-ups can only be done during the three (3) time frames listed above; otherwise, you will be responsible for disposal of the bags.

If you know of a group that would like to be involved in our Adopt-A-Road program, please have them contact us. We currently have routes available for adoption in most of our townships.
