All work is weather permitting. This is the road work schedule for the week of June 9th, 2025.

LANE CLOSURES

Three Mile Road, Hammond Road to South Airport Road (East Bay Township)

- *The Northbound Lane will be closed. Work is expected to last until June 12th. Traffic will be directed by Temporary Signals.
- *Work will take place between 7:00 AM and 5:00 PM, Monday through Thursday.
- *Utility crews will be relocating the Power Poles.
- *Please seek an alternate route or plan for delays.

Three Mile Road Construction Project, Hammond Road to South Airport Road (East Bay Township)

- *Crews will be working on reconstructing this intersection.
- *Work is expected to begin on Thursday, June 12th. Work should take place between 7:00AM and 7:00PM. The entire project is expected to last until the end of August.
- *Three Mile Road will be closed to through traffic.
- *Traffic will need to utilize Hammond Road, Garfield Road and South Airport Road.
- *Please plan ahead, be patient and expect delays.
- *Slow down where workers are present.

Pavement Markings/Long Line (Countywide)

- *The Contractor will continue applying wet paint on various roads between 7:00AM and 7:00PM.
- *These are "moving operations" meaning operations are short-lived in any one location.
- *Motorists should reduce speed and obey traffic control devices.
- *DO NOT DRIVE THROUGH WET PAINT, CONES WILL BE PLACED ON FRESHLY PAINTED AREAS. PAINT WILL END UP ON YOUR VEHICLE IF YOU CHOOSE TO ATTEMPT THIS.**
