Traverse City. *Weather permitting*, this is the current schedule of road work for the week of October 8, 2018.

ROAD CLOSURE: Angell Road, Munro to Bates. Acme Township.

- *Work will be closed from October 15-12, 2018, Monday until Friday.
- *Two culverts are being removed and replacing.
- *Residences west of Munro should access their residences from Bates.
- *Angell Road will be barricaded.
- *See map of closed area.

Silver Lake Road, Franke to Barnes. Garfield Township.

- *Crews will be removing a raised area of asphalt.
- *Southbound traffic will be shifted into one lane.
- *Work is planned for Monday, October 15, 2018 in the morning for a few hours.

Logan's Landing on South Airport Road. Garfield Township.

- *This project is currently scheduled to begin Monday, October 8.
- *This work is expected to last up to an additional two weeks.
- *Traffic will be shifted to one lane in each direction.

South Airport Road, Three Mile to Silver Lake Road. East Bay & Garfield Township.

- *Contractor is working at each signal location along South Airport Road.
- *Special equipment is being installed to improve traffic progression.

Rennie School Road, US-31 to East Silver Lake Road. Garfield Township.

- *Contract crews will be performing crush-and-shape operations.
- *Work is scheduled starting Monday, October 8, between 7 am and 7 pm.
- *Traffic will be directed by flag operations and reduced to one lane.
- *Work will be ongoing for an extended period of time.

Road Commission Crew Activities:

Gravel Roads – Various townships.
Durapatching – Blair Township.
Pothole Patching - Various locations as requested.
