Traverse City. <u>All work is weather permitting.</u> This is the road work schedule for the week starting Monday, January 17, 2022.

TRAFFIC SIGNALS

North Long Lake Road and Barnes Road (Garfield)

- *Crews will be rebuilding the traffic signal and will be in the Right of Way. Signs will be posted in the work area.
- *Work will begin Monday, January 17th at 8:00AM and is expected to last throughout the week. This is part of a larger project.
- *Please use caution in this area. Obey signs and traffic cones.

Garfield Road and Birmely Road (Garfield Township)

- *Crews will be working on the broadband communication system.
- *Work is expected to start around 9:00 AM, Monday morning.
- *Crews will be in the ROW on the shoulder of the road and should not impede traffic.
- *Please use caution in this area.

Hammond Road and Keystone Road (Garfield Township)

- *Crews will be working on the broadband communication system.
- *Crews will begin after the completion of Garfield/Birmley.
- *Crews will be in the ROW on the shoulder of the road and should not impede traffic.
- *Please use caution in this area.

Hammond and Garfield Road (Garfield Township)

- *Crews will be working on the broadband communication system.
- *Crews will begin after the completion of Hammond/Keystone.
- *Crews will be working in the southwest corner of the intersection, within the turning radius of the road, closest to the shoulder. Eastbound traffic will still be able to turn right/south onto Garfield.
- *Please use caution in this area. Slow down and obey traffic cones.
